Wm Harrison of Chesterfield County being very sick in body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be given unto God therefore calling unto mind the mortality of my body knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make & certify this my last Will & Testament

First of all I give & recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it & my body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a quiet Christian manner of Buriall at the Discretion of my well beloved Friend Wm Worldridge nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty Power of God and as touching such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to bestow ^{on} me in this Life I give devise & dispose of them in the following manner & form

First I give unto my grand Daughter Polly Wm Worldridge daughter of William

to do as much & certain this my last Will & Testament

Principally & first of all I give & recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it & my body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a quiet Christian manner of Buriall at the Discretion of my well Beloved Friend W. Woodbridge Nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty Power of God and as touching such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to bestow ^{on} me in this Life I give demise & dispose of them in the following manner & form

First I give unto my grand Daughter Polly Woodbridge Daughter of William Woodbridge the best Bed & Furniture belonging to it

I give unto my Daughter Elizabeth Winfree one Shilling Sterling Likewise I give to my son Ezekiel Naughton one Shilling Sterling

Likewise I give to Fleming Woodbridge one tract of Land being one

hundred acres in Chesterfield County it being the most barren land I have

Likewise I give to Harrison Woodruffe a tract of land lying in Patrick County
there being one hundred & eighty seven acres

Likewise I give to Fleming Woodruffe my largest Pot & Hacks belonging to it

Likewise the remainder part of my Estate to be equally divided between Fleming
