I In the name of God amen I Thomas a Saddler of the County of Chesterfield being of
Will Sound mind & memory do hereby ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner & in
form following that is to say

First my Debts & funeral Expenses to be first paid

Item I give & bequeath to my son Thomas Sadler my
bed & also my negro man Henry on my son Thomas Sadler paying to
my grand sons James Hatcher & Nathaniel Hatcher twenty five pounds
each to them & their heirs forever

Item I give to my grand son Jacob Sadler son of my son Thomas Sadler
the Bed & Furniture that I now make use of & is generally called my bed

Item I give to my Daughter Judith Sadler the Bed & Furniture that she
generally lies on & is called her bed & one white & half also three pewter Dishes & an
Pail my Desire is that remainder part of my Estate that I have not already
given away to be equally divided between my son Thomas Sadler my Daughter
Mary Hatcher & my Daughter Judith Sadler to them & their heirs forever

Lastly I appoint my son Thomas Sadler & Elizabeth Hatcher my Executors
of this my last Will & Testament recoking all former Wills by me made &c

Rests my Desire is that remainder part of my Estate that I have not already
given away to be equally divided between my Son Thomas Sadler my Daughter
Mary Ketchum & my Daughter Judah Sadler to them & their heirs forever
Lastly I repeat my Son Thomas Sadler & Elizabeth Ketchum my Executors
of this my last Will & Testament revoking all former Wills by me made &c
Desire that my Estate may not be appraised. *Witness* my hand & seal
this twenty fourth Day of Decem^r. one thousand seven hundred & eighty
