I have given unto my Daughter Lucy by birth one Third Furniture & one
thousand pounds Cash.

I have & the rest of my Estate I give unto my said Daughter Charles & his
Susan Christian the remainder part of my Estate consisting one Negro Man
named Peter also my House hold & Kitchen Furniture also my stock & all my
outstanding Debts to be equally divided between the said two Charles & Susan
also I point my son Charles Christian & Charles by birth my Executors
also my Will to be proved in the County of Chesterfield.
