In the name of God amen I Walter Scott Senr. of Chesterfield in Manchester
Parish being of sound & perfect Memory do constitute & make this my last Will &
Testament in manner & form following

Imprimus I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Scott a feather Bed &
Furniture which she now possesses likewise any Room which she may choose in my
Estate & that she may have the use of the Room which she now occupies during her natural
Life but not to lease or rent the said Room out & that she may be maintained out of the
Estate at the discretion of my Executor.

I give unto my Wife Agnes Scott the use of all my Lands Negroes Stock of all kind
Also all my House - Hold & Kitchen Furniture with the Plantations & utensils &c.
during her natural Life & after her Decease to be disposed of as follows

Item I give unto my Son Wm Scott twenty Shillings Sterling Dr. & to the Executor

Testament in manner & form following

I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Scott a feather Bed & Furniture which she now possesses likewise any House which she may choose in my Estate, that she may have the use of the Room which she now occupies during her natural Life but not to lease or rent the said Room out & that she may be maintained out of the Estate at the discretion of my Executors.

I give unto my Wife Agnes Scott the use of all my Lands Negroes Stock of all kind Also all my House - Kitchens Furniture with the Plantations Attendants &c. during her natural Life & after her Decease to be disposed of as follows

Item I give unto my Son Wm Scott twenty Shillings Sterling Dr. 4th to 10th June 1784
made at Richmond Va. May 1784

Item I give unto my son Walter Scott the Land & Plantation whereon I now live on both sides of the creek from ~~the~~ Spring Branch on the south

up the said branch of all the lands on the north of the creek excepting the same
lands on the creek below the Mouth of the said steep branch Likewise a Negro Man
Livy to him & his Heirs forever

Item I give unto my son James Scott the lands which he now possesses from
the upper line down to lower quarter branch then up the said branch to
a marked line thence up the said line the main road including all the said
lands on both sides the creek down to the Mouth of lower quarter branch
Likewise a Negro Man Sam to him & his Heirs forever

Item I give unto my son Andrew Scott all the remainder of my lands not as
yet disposed of Likewise the following Slaves & their increase Viz. Lucy, Tom,
Solah & Joe to him & his Heirs forever

Item I give unto my Daughter Ann Winfree a Negro Girl Gift to her
Increase to her & her Heirs

I am I give unto my Daughter Ann Mifflin a Negroe Girl by the
Increase to her & her Heirs

I am I give unto my Daughter Jane Scott a Negroe Man named John
a Spoon a feather Bed & Furniture to her & her Heirs

I am I give unto my Daughter Lucanah Scott a Negroe Man named Peter
a boy named Jack & any Horse which she may choose in my Estate Likewise
a feather Bed & Furniture to her & her Heirs

I am I give unto my Daughter Martha Scott a Negroe Man named Tom & a Girl
Fanny Likewise a feather Bed & Furniture & a bell mottle spire Mortar to her & her Heirs

I am I give unto my Daughter Morley Scott a Negroe Man named Isaac a Negroe
Woman Ann a boy Frank Likewise a feather Bed & Furniture & a bell mottle Skillet
to her & her Heirs

It is my Will & desire that the remainder of my Estate both real & personal being
divided among my three Sons Viz. Walter James Scott & John & their Heirs &
either or any of my Sons Walter James Scott ^{Scott} should die before the death of their Mother
or without a law full issue of their body then it is my desire that their part of the Estate be
equally divided between the surviving parties to them & their Heirs &

And I do hereby constitute & appoint my Wife Agnes Scott Executrix. My Sons William
Scott Walter Scott & James Scott Executors to this my last Will & Testament In Witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & fixed my seal this twenty ninth Day of April
one thousand seven hundred & eighty two
