& Furniture one bed & ball two hooter Pishes six hooter Flais four chairs one Trunk

Item I give devise & bequeath to my Daughter Hannah Turner one feather Bed
& Furniture one bed & half two pewter Dishes six pewter Plates four chairs one Trunk
one Small Table & one Chest to her & her Heirs forever

Item my Desire is that my Daughter Hannah Turner may live on the Plantation
where now I now live during her Life or being single without interruption of any person

Item I give devise & bequeath to my Daughter Lucy Turner five Shillings current
Money to her & her Heirs forever

Item I give devise & bequeath to my Daughter Tabitha Ketcher five Shillings current
Money to her & her Heirs forever

Item I give devise & bequeath to my grand Daughter Mary Turner one feather Bed
& Furniture to her & her Heirs forever

Item I give devise & bequeath to my loving Wife one high nailed Trunk two pewter

Item I give & devise unto my said Wife Mary Turner

Item I give & devise unto my said Wife Mary Turner during her natural Life & after her Decease

I give devise & bequeath the same to my son William Turner his Heirs & Assigns forever

Item I give devise & bequeath to said Wife Mary Turner one small Desk to her & her Heirs forever

Item I give my said Wife my Negro Man Peter during her Life & after her Decease
I give devise & bequeath the said Negro to my son William Turner his Heirs & Assigns forever

Item I give devise & bequeath to my Wife Mary Turner one Horse & Bridle to be
Saddled to her & her Heirs forever

Item I give devise & bequeath to my said Wife & to my son William Turner all
the remainder parts of Estate not before mentioned to them & their Heirs forever

I add to her two fowls

Now I give devise & bequeath to my said Wife & my son William Turner all the remainder part of Estate not before mentioned to them & their heirs forever to be equally divided between them

And lastly I nominate & appoint my son William Turner sole & full Executor of this my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this twenty eighth Day of February one thousand seven hundred & eighty
