by them my said three grand Daughters as Tenants in common
and not as joint tenants

Them I give devise and bequeath all the Remains and Residue of my
Estate of every kind and Denomination whatsoever both real and
personal to my son Orchard Wallhath and his heirs and assigns
forever and I direct that my Estate be not appraised and doth
hereby nominate constitute, my said son Orchard Wallhath my
whole and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament in
Witness whereof I the said William Wallhath hath hereunto set my
Hand and affixed my Seal this 25th Day of December 1800

and their respective heirs forever and for the said Lots to be held
by them my said three grand Daughters as Tenants in common
and not as joint tenants

Item I give devise and bequeath all the Remainder and Residue of my
Estate of every kind and Commencement whatsoever both real and
personal to my son Orchard Wallhatch and his heirs and assigns
I do hereby declare that my Estate be not affected and doth
hereby nominate constitute, my said son Orchard Wallhatch my
sole and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament in
Witness whereof I the said William Wallhatch hath hereunto set my
Hand and affixed my Seal this eighth Day December one thousand
and seven hundred and eighty eight
