Do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner & form following
Wit.

Item I give & bequeath to my Son John Wilson all the Land with the Mill
being the Land that is enclosed by the building the said Mill also my
Negro Man Jack also my boy Moses Saddle & Bridle also two horses one
Yearling one half also two Hens one or one p^r Traces also all my Leather
that I have or have with my Shoemakers Tools to him & his Heirs forever.

Item I give to my Son William Wilson the Land In or near one being
by estimation one hundred Acres be the same more or less also two Horses
to him & his Heirs forever

Item I further gave to my Son John Wilson all my Crop of Corn
What on my Plantation either growing or made also meadow of
Iron Wedges as also all the Crop be it of whatsoever kind it be to
him & his Heirs forever.

Item my Will is that all the rest of my estate not yet given away
be equally divided between my Son John Wilson & my Daughter
Ann Blankinship to them & their Heirs forever.

Item my will is that my Estate be not appraised.

Item I also constitute & appoint my Son John Wilson & my
Friend Thomas Winkham my whole & sole Executors of this my

last Will & Testament revoking all other Wills by me made. In
Testimony whereof I have set my hand & affixed my seal this ninth
Day of August one thousand seven hundred & seventy seven.

Item my will is that my Estate be not appraised
