Will present, Daniel & Abraham Test & others were sworn and severally depone that they were well acquainted with the Testator & that writing and verily believe that the said Writing and the name then to subscribe to be wholly written by the Testator & that the same Writing is or ought to be received as the true & last Will & Testament of the said George Test Dec^d.

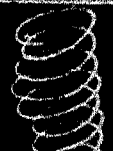
On the Motion of Nathaniel Test Executor of George Test Dec^d who made Oath according to Law and together with the said other deponents & others as aforesaid & now before the Court in the Penalty of the Statute from Andrew Hollan Constable of the said County for his failure to obtain a Probate of the said Will in due Form &c.

On the Motion of Nathaniel Test Executor of George Test Dec^d & also that same Abraham Daniel & Abraham James H. Brooks & Paul Price any three of whom to wit having been first duly sworn do affirm the Slaves of any and all the Personal Estate of George Test Dec^d as a part accing to Law.
