Virginia make this my Last Will and Testament Giving to my Wife all the Property I die possessed
of both Real and Personal, except my Library, which I give to my beloved son, trusting he may
derive more advantage from it than his unfortunate Father has done.

of whom to act having been first duly sworn its appearance the Service of any, and other Personal
