cessors my Will is that the same Right in that which may be purchased as the does in that which
would be sold then and in fact I authorize my Executors in conjunction with my Wife Rebecca
Watson to sell and convey the same and if the Sale should be made and the Land purchased
the former was is to be made to my Heirs namely Lyman & Amos Watson George Ephraim & William May
rebecca & William and Thomas & brother Watson to them and their Heirs and assigns forever.

Notwithstanding, if either of my Philopenses, or names, have should either of them die before they
arrive to the Age of twenty One Year, then and in that case, it will pass into the Hands of the surviving
Philopene, to them and their Heirs forever.

I do hereby appoint and authorize my Father Thomas Weston my Executor to execute this my last Will and Testament.

In consequence of I have set my Hand to this tenth Day of April One Thousand Eight
and Forty One and further I certify to my Brother Thomas Watson Junr

My Will and Desire is that my Executors should sell this Land I have in Frank County that is
say of the money arising from the said Land and to be laid out in Land more suitable for my Wife
then my life holding the same Right in that which may be purchased as she does in that which
would be sold then and in fact I authorize my Executors in conjunction with my Wife Rebecca
Watson to sell and convey the same and if the said Land should be more and other Land purchased
the foregoing is to be made to my Heirs namely Lyman and William Joseph Ephraim Watson Mary
and Rebecca Watson and Thomas and Peter Watson to them and their Heirs and assigns forever

Notwithstanding if either of my Children or mine a son should either of them die before they
arrive to the Age of twenty One years then and in that case the said property should pass into the Hands of the surviving
Children to them and their Heirs forever

Lastly I do hereby appoint and authorize my Brother Thomas Watson my Executors to ex-
ecute the within Will and Testament

Debts and funeral Expenses excepting a certain Debt which I owe to the Court of the State
of Smithfield which said Debt is secured to me by a Deed of Trust on my Real Estate and
that the Persons if any they are to deliver
