Deficiency shall be made.

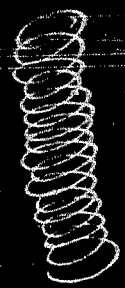
Item. That I give and bequeath to my eldest Son John (Son of my Brother James Mustin) all my
