I Richard Hurdlesby of Gloucestershire and County of Gloucester do hereby make my Last Will and Testament in manner and form following hereby revoking all others former, Wills by me heretofore made.

FIRST = I direct my Executors hereinafter named to pay all my just debts and General Charges out of my Personal Estate that can be best spared by my Executors should the same be having it to him should be necessary to all any of the Payment of my debts and General Expenses to select the Property that shall be sold.

SECOND = I direct my said Executors to make a complete Inventory of all my Personal Estate as well as the debts due me at my Death and of the Payment of all my debts as a bona requirere and I give and devise all the Real and Personal of my Estate both Real and Personal to my beloved Wife Sarah who should the survivor me for and during her natural Life - but in the Event of her marrying again it is my Will that she shall only have One Third of my Real and Personal Estate for her Life, and direct that her Dowry be laid off in my Land and Money as soon there after as may be done conveniently, and that the Wines and other Property which she has received or may then after receive, and which have not been consumed in the actual Use thereof for her Support and Maintenance shall be returned to my Estate at her Death to be divided with my other Property, as hereafter directed.

THIRD = I give and devise all my Real and Personal Estate to whomsoever I may be seized or possessed of and entitled to subject to the Power and Grace to my said Wife for Life as before directed to the said Wife.

Second = I direct my said Executor to make a complete Inventory of all my Personal Estate as
will at the death due my said Death and after the Payment of all my debts to as a bond require
and I give and devise all the Real and Personal Estate to my beloved
Wife Sarah to have and enjoy during her Natural Life - but in the Event
of her marrying again it is my Will that she shall only have One Third of any Real and Personal
Estate for her Life, and direct that her Dowry be laid off in my said Land and Negroes as soon there
after as may be done conveniently, and that the Homes and other Property which she has received or
may then receive, and which have not been consumed in the actual Use thereof for her Support
and Maintenance shall be returned to my Estate at her Death to be disposed with my other Property,
as hereafter directed.

Third = I give and devise all my Real and Personal Estate to whomsoever I may
die seized or possessed of and entitled to subject to the Power of Grace to my said Wife for Life or
Whosoever to the Eleven Children now living by my said Wife Sarah Ann or such other Child
or Children as may hereafter be born of our said Marriage, them Heirs and Assigns to be equally divid
ed between them should I die alive at the Death or Marriage of any said Wife, as the
same may. or in the Event of my surviving her at my Death but should any of my said
Children die without having a Child or Children at his or her Death then the Survivors before
mentioned shall take such Share or Shares as the same may be.

At a Court held for the County of Lawrence on Monday the 25th Day of February
1848 the Last Will and Testament of Richard Hargrett deceased was produced in Court and was sworn
of the County of Lawrence Wm. Hargrett and Treasurer of the two of which being attested for him to

On the Motion of William Hargrett Notary the Court in the usual manner
made an order according to Law and of the Court the Paul Pierce, Richard Hargrett, Wm. Hargrett and
Notary hereinafter mentioned and acknowledged them in the County of Lawrence and in the
