Last Will Testament
Robert P. Page.
Dec 9,

I Robert Page of the County of Clarke and state of Virginia do make and
publish this my last Will and Testament.

I give to my wife Susan for her life the farm upon which I live freehold of
Land the property rec'd by me from my Father being all the land I have at
present the tenth part of the same being of ten acres be given to each of my
two daughters equally and the other part of the same shall be equally divided
between them to be used for their support and maintenance
I give to my son John Page the farm which he now occupies and
the house thereon and all the property belonging thereto.

to my present wife all my house hold & Kitchen furniture except the articles recd
as above mentioned from Mrs. Francis & whatever else may have been recd. with
my first wife. I also give her all the stock & farming utensils upon the estate
including Carrage on & horses & one third part of all Bank Stock & bonds or
other debts due to me after payment of my debts & funeral expenses.

I also give her Mr. John Gouttans bond which is for the purchase money of
the Hillwood Mill & Negro Phill Lemmon - the Mill was her property
before Marriage, & Phill was bought in exchange for one of her Negroes sole - as

By a like conveyance made to Nathl. Burwell but after my becoming marriage I assign
to my present wife all the property I recd. with her which I should hold at my death
I either provide or intend to provide that she should have the benefit of any property
which I might sell & under purchase with the proceeds of any part of the said property
I might sell - I have sold several of her negroes, & some of the money arising from
such sales was applied in part payment of the sum given her by to my three eldest
Daughters. I have also recd. several sums of money in her right from the Estate of Robt.
A. Burwell as an equivalent for the property thus sold -

The will have under the conveyance above mentioned all the negroes I rec'd with
her or their increase, except such as I have sold, & as they are numerous & valuable
I do not give her as donee, any of the negroes not rec'd in her right of which I may
be possessed. It is my Will that all the property of which I am or may be
possessed at my death no be disposed of after the foregoing part of this Will be equal
by division among all my children & the heirs of them whom ever may survive -
I do hereby constitute & appoint my wife Susan N Page, & my brother John E.
Page the executors & executors of this will, & I desire & direct that no security
be required of them or either of them.

fodical bond was produced in Court by John E. Page one of the Executors in the
said Will named, which said will & testament was proven by the Oaths of the
Pages Benj Harrison the two Subscribing Witnesses thereto and ordered to be
Recorded. And the said bond to the said Will was proven in part by the Oaths of Page
and Harrison. One of the Subscribing Witnesses to the said Bond and ordered to be
for further prov. And the said bond to the Last Will & Testament of Robt P. Page
Dec'd was this Day fully proven by the Oaths of Mary C. Page the other Subscribing
Witness to the said Bond; which bond is thereupon ordered to be Recorded
with the said Last Will & Testament of Robt P. Page Dec'd.

On the motion of John E. Page, one of the Executors named in the Last Will & Testa-
ment of Robt P. Page Dec'd who made oath according to Law in the Terms of the
said Will not requiring any security to be taken entering into an Acknowledgment thereof
in the Penalty of Eighty Thousand Dollars conditioned as the Law directs. Certificate is
granted him for obtaining Probate of the said Last Will and Testament of Robt P.
Page Dec'd in due form &c ad. &c.

Ordered by the court that Robt C. Randolph, Nathl B. Whiting, Benj Harrison &
John Page any three of whom to act having been first duly sworn do appraise the
Slaves if any and other Personal Estate of Robt P. Page Dec'd's report according to Law.
