and ordain this my last will and Testament as follows First
Do humbly Recommend my soul to Almighty God from whom I
received it fully Trusting through the merits of my Blessed Redeemer
Jesus Christ to receive pardon and Remission for all my sins and
Enjoy Eternal Felicity and my Body I commit to the earth (from whence
it came) therein to be Decently Interred in a Christian like manner
at the Discretion of my Executors and as Touching my worldly Estate
after my Funeral Charges and Just Debts are paid and Discharged
I Dispose of the same as follows Viz

Item I Give and Confirm - to my son John Field and his heirs and
assigns forever the lot and portion of Land which I have already made
him a Deed of Gift for & is now in Possession of as also Two negro Boys

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Enjoy Eternal Felicity and my Body I commit to the earth (from whence
I came) therein to be Decently Interred in a Christian like manner
at the Discretion of my Executors and as Touching my worldly Estate
after my Funeral Charges and Just Debts are paid and Discharged
Dispose of the same as follows Viz

Item I Give and Confirm - to my son John Field and his heirs and
assigns forever the lot and portion of Land which I have already made
him a Deed of Gift for & is now in Possession of as also Two Negroe Boys
Named Dory and Robin which he has in his possession

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Item I Give and Confirm to my son Daniel Field his heirs and assigns
forever the lot and portion of Land which I have already made him
a Deed of Gift for which he was in possession of as also two Negroes
Named James and Lot and her future Increase from the Day that
he had the said Negroes, Lot in his Possession

Item I Give to my Daughter Judith Gancey two negroes named
ned and peter which she had in her Possession and as she has
lately Deceased my Desire is that Capt Richard Gancey her

husband should enjoy the same time & his heirs forever.

Item I Give to my Daughter Elisabeth ~~Esford~~ two negroes named Dembo and Lucey which she has now in her Possession with the future increase of the said Lucey from the day that she had her in her Possession to her and her heirs forever.

Item I Give to my Daughter Ellenor Greenwood two negroes named Sam and Sarah with the future Increase of the said Sarah During her natural life and at her Decese to fall to my Grandson John Greenwood to him and his heirs forever which said Negroes the said Ellenor Greenwood has now in her Possession

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Item I Give to my son Henry Field the Road Plantation and the Land thereto belonging according to W Youngs survey together with two negroes named Moses and Moll together with the future Increase of the said Moll also one Grey horse and one feather bed and Furniture all which he has in his Possession to him and his heirs forever.

Item I Give to my Grandson Abraham Field and his heirs and assigns forever the land and plantation whereon Benjamin Hughes formerly lived bounded according to W Youngs survey the

Formerly Lived bound according to Mr Youngs survey thereof which
he has had in his Possession by a deed of Gift also the sum of thirty
Pounds to be paid in two years after my Decease by my Executors to
him and his heirs forever which with what his father has had and
what he has had himself and is to have I think is Equal with the
Rest of my Children.

I do Give and Confirm to my son William Field and his heirs and assigns forever the Lot and portion of Land which I have already made him a Good of Gift for also two Negroes ^{James and} ~~James~~ ^{James and} James which he has had in his Possession.

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Now I lend to my beloved wife Hannah Field during her natural life the land and plantation wherein I now live containing by survey made by M^r Young three hundred and forty one acres and after my wifes Decese I give it to my three sons Abaaham Reuben & Abner Field to be Equally Divided Between them and their heirs forever and it is also my Desire is that if either of my three sons Abaaham Reuben or Abner Field should Die without Issue before they Possess the said Land that then their part of the said Land should be

him and his heirs forever which with what his father has had and
what he has had himself and is to have I think is equal with the
Rest of my Children.

Item I Give and Confirm to my son William Field and his heirs and af-
forever the lot and portion of land which I have already made him a Freed
of Gift for also two Negroes named Bacchus and James which he has had
in his Possession.

Item I lend to my beloved wife Hannah Field during her natural
life the land and plantation which my Father conveyed by Survey
made by Mr Young three hundred and forty one acres and after my
wifes Decese I Give it to my three sons Abraham Reuben & Abner
Field to be Equally Divided Between them and their heirs forever
and it is also my Desire is that if either of my three sons Abraham
Reuben or Abner Field should Die without Issue before they Possess
the said Land that then their part of the said Land should Equally
Desend to the Survivors or Survivor.

Item I Give and bequeath to my wife Hannah Field and her

Four Children Abraham Beuben Abner and Jenny Field
all the Residue of my Estate viz Thirteen negroes named Tom
Sampson Jacob Man Rose Bet Peg Charles Melley Arney Ned Ralph
and Vincent to be Equally Divided with all the Residue of my
whatsoever the Division not to be till the Death of my wife or
the arrival of my son Abner to the age of Twenty one years which
where my son Abner ^{shall} come to the age of Twenty one years that then
each Child shall be at liberty to take their own part of the Estate
Now if my wife should ~~marry a second~~ <sup>Culpeper County, Virginia Wills
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come to the age of Twenty one years it is my Desire that the Division
shall then be made but if she should not Marry the Division not
to be till my son Abner come to the age of Twenty one years all which
I Give them and their heirs forever now if any one or more should
Die of the above named Hannah Field Abraham Beuben Abner
and Jenny Field without heir that their part of my Estate which
falls to them to be Equally Divided among the survivors of the
above named Hannah Field Abraham Beuben Abner & Jenny
Field all which I Give to them and their heirs forever

above named Hannah Field Abraham Brecken Abner & Perry
Field all which I give to them and their heirs forever it is also
my Desire that my Estate should be Equally Divided as above mentioned
and not to be sold

Lastly I do nominate and appoint my said wife Hannah Field
Executor of this my Last will and Testament hereby Revoking all
former - wills by me made In witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal this second day of July one Thousand seven
hundred and seventy four

In the name God Amen the 23rd Day of January Seventeen
Hundred and seventy five I Richard Young of Culpeper County in
Virginia being ~~very sick and weak in~~ Body but of perfect mind and
Memory thanks be given to God. therefore calling unto mind the
Mortality of my Body and knowing that is appointed for all men
once to die do make and Ordain this my Last will and Testament
that is to say Principally and first of all I Give and Recommend my
soul into the hands of God that Gave it and my Body I Recommend
to the earth to be buried in Decent christian Burial at the Discretion
of my Executors herein after Expressing nothing Doubting but at the General
Resurrection I shall receive the same Again by the mighty power of God
I do hereby bequeath my last Will and Testament to be in full force and effect
