attests In the name of God amen the eighteenth day of March  
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and seventy  
four, I Ann Abbott of Culpeper County being very sick and weak

in Body but of perfect mind and Memory thanks be given to  
God for the same and calling to mind the Mortality of my  
Body and Knowing that is appointed for all men once to die  
do make and Ordain this my Last will and Testament that  
is to say principally and first of all I give and Recommend  
my soul into the hands of God that gave it and for my Body  
Recommend it to the Earth to be Buried in a Christian like  
manner at the Discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but  
at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again by  
the mighty power of God and as Touching such Worldly Estate  
whereunto it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life  
I give Divorse and Dispose of in the manner following

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That is to say, I ~~here~~ give and Bequeath unto Margaret my  
Daughter and Armistead and Pusey White my Grandsons  
my Worldly Estate and all Debts and Demands due to me  
from William Abbott and Roger Abbott or either of them or any  
other person or persons whatsoever to be Equally divided  
between my aforesaid ~~Daughter~~ and Grandsons. I do

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hereby appoint my Two Grandsons Armistead White and  
Pusey White Executors to this my Last Will and Testament  
hereby utterly disavowing revoking and making void  
all and every other Will and Wills heretofore by me made  
Ratifying and confirming this and no other and no
