fillis But not to be delivered till my Executors shal  
think fitt

Item I Give unto my Daughter Ann Woolner  
my negro Gail Cold Hannah to be Delivered when my  
Executor shal think fitt

Item my Will and Desire is that all the Rest of my Effat  
Personall and Reall after my Debts are Paid shal be at  
the Disposall of my Executor During his Life

211) Desires is that my Estate may not be Appraised my Will is  
that all my Estate Remaining after the Decease of my  
Executor be Equally Divided Between my three Daughters  
Elizabeth and Wenefred and Jane and my three Youngest  
Sons Richard and John and William and if any one of the  
fore mentioned Children Chance to Marry in the life  
time of my Executor she may Dispose of any Part of the Estate  
that think fitt for there Subsistances it is my Desire my  
three Sons be put out such Trades as they are most desirous  
of when they are at the age of sixteen

Lastly I do Constitute and Appoint my loving Wife
