Edward Jones, Corporal, and William Jones - soldiers under Col. George Washington, both of whom died in service

John Baker Turner, Christopher Fielding, Patrick Ritchie - soldiers under Col. Washington Joseph Grimsley and John Brumley - soldiers in 2nd Virginia Regiment commanded by Col. Byrd

Francis Barnes, Thomas Murphy - soldiers in 1758 under Gen. Forbes

Martin Nalle - under Maj. John Field in 1764 in an expedition against the Shawnee Indians

John Chisholm and Henry Nixon - soldiers in 1758 under Capt. and John Field in Gen. Forbes' expedition against the French and Indians

Alex Waugh Jr. - staff officer for Virginia forces under Col. Byrd in 1758
