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George Washington's First Job

George Washington held his first job in Culpeper.

Lord Fairfax, who owned a vast estate of land in Virginia, was the patron of young George and engaged him at age 16 to survey his property in the Culpeper area. In July, 1749, George Washington, Gent., then 17, was commissioned by the College of William and Mary as surveyor for the new County of Culpeper. The house on East Spencer Street in which he is said to have roomed while surveying the town of Culpeper in 1749 was demolished in 1974 to make way for a parking lot.
