Ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner following. First it is my
desire that all my Just Debts be paid, Secondly I lend to my dear and loving
wife all my Estate during her life or Widowhood I make no doubt but she
will keep my children as they stand by the lent of such things as they
stand in need of at her Discretion but if in case my said wife should
choose to Marry again then it is my desire that my Estate be all taken out of
her hands Except one eighth part thereof which I give unto her & her heirs forever
Thirdly I give to my two sons after my wife's Decease, namely Thomas Davis
Jesse Davis my right of the Lot of Land now live on to be Equally Divided
between them —

Fourthly It is my desire that the whole Remainder of my Estate be Equally divided amongst my seven children namely William Davis alias William Leonard, Fanny Davis alias Fanny Leonard, Siddy Davis, Richard Davis, Thomas Davis, Betty Davis & Jesse Davis & it is my desire that in case any of my's children should die before they come of age or marry that their part should be Equally Divided amongst the Survivor & their Representatives which I give unto my said children their Heirs & assigns lastly I do Ordain and appoint my Friends William Shenell and John Wigginton Executors to this my last will and Testament
