to be my last Will and Testament that is to say
Principally and first of all I give and
recommend my Soul into the Hands of Almighty
God that gave it, and my Body I recommend
to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like
Manner at the Discretion of my Executors
hereafter mentioned. And as touching my
Worldly Estates wherewith it hath pleased God
to give me in this Life I give demise and right
of the same in Manner and Form following viz
Inprimis I give and bequeath unto my Daughter
Sarah Norman all thatting and she to have no

of the same in Manner and Form as of
Imprimis I give and bequeath unto my Daughter
Sarah Norman one Skitting and she to have no
more of my Estate.

Item I leave and bequeath unto my dear and
loving Wife Margaret after my just Debts are
satisfied and paid all my Personal Estate of
what kind soever during her Natural Life and
after her Decease I give and bequeath the same
to my Son William McMurrin his Heirs and
assigns forever &c.

Lastly I do nominate and appoint my loving Wife
Margaret McMurrin and my Son William
McMurrin whole and sole Executors and Executors
of this my Last Will and Testament revoking
and disannulling all Wills heretofore made
by me and confirming this and this only to be

my last Will and Testament in Manner and Form
aforesaid In Testimony whereof I have hereunto
set my Hand and affixed my Seal this twenty
second day of May Anno Dom' 1750.
