Item I give to my two sons Michael and George Utz my still to hold Equally to them and their Heirs forever.

Item I give to my beloved Wife Barbara Utz all the remainder of my Estate Real & Personal During her Living a Widow and after her Decease or Marriage then to be Equally Divided among my Children that is to say Michael Utz, George Utz, and Margret Blankenbecher to hold to them and their Heirs forever.

Wit. I do hereby constitute and Appoint my two sons Michael and George Utz Executors of this my last & Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 28th day of June 1770.
