Item I give unto my son Robert Butcher the lease or Lot of Land
whereon I now live to him and his Heirs forever.

in case she Inter-marries it is my desire that she shall have one half
of the Lease Land at the death or Inter-marriage of my wife I give unto my
two sons Coleman and William Crutcher the Tract of Land I now possess
to be Equally divided Between them according to Quantity & Quality
to them and their Heirs forever

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Item I give unto my son Robert Crutcher the Lease or Lot of Land
whereon I now live to him and his Heirs forever

Item It is my will and desire that all my Estate shall be kept together until
my Youngest child comes of age & then to be Equally divided among
my wife and Children and in case of the death of any of my children

to be divided among them living or among their heirs deceased
them at the death of my beloved wife it is my desire she the part sent
her to be equally divided among my children or their heirs &c
Lastly I appoint my loving wife Elizabeth, Edward Watkins French
Mother and Samuel Clayton my Executors of this my Last Will
and Testament, whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
