Ordain this my last Will and Testament that is to say
and first of all I give and Recommend my Soul into the hands
of the Almighty God that gave it trusting and securely to clearing
that through the Merits of my blessed Saviour I shall
full forgiveness and Remission of all my Sins and my
Recommend to the Earth to be Buried in decent husbandry
Burial Nothing relating but that, at the General Resurrection
I shall receive the same again by the mighty Power of God
as touching such is our Duty to God as has pleased God to do

that through the Merits of my Blessed Saviour I shall
full forgiveness and Remission of all my Sins and my
Freedom unto the Earth to be Buried in decent Christian
Burial Nothing holding but that, at the General Resurrection
I shall receive the same again by the mighty Power of God
as touching such is or Old Estate as it has pleased God to bestow
me with in this Life I do Dispose and Dispose of the same in
the following manner and form

Truly I give and bequeath unto my Beloved and Lawful
Heir the use of my house and Plantation whereon I now live
during the term of her Natural Life and after my Beloved
Wifes Decease my Beloved Son Mathias is to have the said
House and Plantation whereon I now do live containing
hundred and fifty six acres of land to him and his heirs forever
and if in case the said my Son Mathias Should die

him and his heirs forever and if in lo and the next youngest son
should die without an heir then the next youngest son is to
have it for him and his heirs forever

Secondly I give and bequeath unto my beloved son Peter Broil
one hundred acres of Land a Boast a Cow and Calf and a Pig
and a Pot and a Pan the said Hundred Acres of Land to be
taken off of a Tract of four hundred acres of Land which I
possess in my own Right and title to be taken off with a Crops
line to him and his heirs forever

Thirdly I give and bequeath unto my beloved son Michael
Broil one hundred acres of Land a Boast a Cow and Calf and a
Pig and a Pot and a Pan the said one hundred Acres of Land is to
be taken off of the before mentioned tract of four hundred Acres

to be taken off of the beforementioned tract of four hundred Acres
of Land to be taken off with a crop line to him and his heirs forever
Fourthly I give and bequeath unto my Beloved Son John Brown
one Hundred Acres of Land a Boar a Cow and Calf and a Pig
and a pot and pan the said one hundred Acres of Land to be taken
off of the beforementioned Tract of four hundred Acres of Land
with a crop line for him and his heirs forever

Fifthly I give and bequeath unto my Beloved Son Zacharias
Brown one hundred Acres of Land a Boar a Cow and Calf, a Pig
and a pot and pan the said one hundred Acres of Land to be taken
off of the beforementioned Tract of four hundred Acres of Land
with a crop line to him and his heirs forever

Sixthly I give and bequeath ^{to my} my Beloved Daughter Mary
Brown a Cow and Calf and a Pig and a Pot and pan and

Seventhly it is my Will and Desire that all the Rest of

shares, I shall be Equally Divided among my Sons and Daughters
that is to say my son Adam Broil, and my son Nicholas

and my son Peter Broil, and my son Michael Broil, and
my son John Broil and my son Zacharias Broil, and
my son Matthias Broil, and my beloved Daughter
Catharine Wayland and my beloved Daughter Elizabeth
Wilkie and my beloved Daughter Mary Broil to
them and their heirs forever

Eighthly and Lastly I make and Ordain my Beloved
