Item I also give and bequeath to the said Isabella Hill one Bed and Furniture to her and her Heirs forever

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Item I give and bequeath to Lydia Hill Daughter to the said Isabella one Pewter dish and three plates to her and her Heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to Mary Hill daughter of the said Isabella one pewter dish and three plates to her and her Heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to Penny Hill Daughter of Isabella one Bridle and side saddle three pewter Basons & one plate to her & her Heirs forever

I also give and bequeath to the said Penny Daughter of Isabella three Knives

and four forks to her and her Heirs forever

Item it is my will and desire that all my wearing apparel shall be equally divided between Elisabeth Page Sarah Cook Ann Treacy and the above mentioned Isabella Hill she the said Isabella Hill having the Cloak beside her equal part of the apparel to them and their Heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to Elisabeth Cambwell one bow and Calf likewise one Bed and furniture to her and her Heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath <sup>Culpeper County, Virginia Wills
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Item I also give and bequeath to the said Eliza Cambwell one sow and three piggs to her and her Heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath Eliza Page and Sarah Cook Fourteen sheep and Twenty head of hogs to be equally divided between them to them and their Heirs forever

Item I also give and bequeath to the said Elisabeth Page and Sarah Cook

Two Horses one horse a month the other a half

divided between Elisabeth Page Sarah Cook Ann Treacy and the above
mentioned Isabella Hill she the said Isabella Hill having the Cloak beside
her equal part of the apparel to them and their Heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to Elisabeth Cambwell one Cow and Calf
likewise one Bed and furniture to her and her Heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto the s^d Elisabeth Cambwell one Black mare
to her and her Heirs forever

Item I also give and bequeath to the said Eliz. Cambwell one sow and
three piggs to her and her Heirs forever

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Item I give and bequeath Eliz Page and Sarah Cook Fourteen sheep and
Twenty head of hogs to be equally divided between them, to them and
their Heirs forever

Item I also give and bequeath to the said Elisabeth Page and Sarah Cook
Two Horses one being a white the other a black, and my Pots and other
Iron utensils such as Chairs and Articles remaining not heretofore
men-

Mentioned to be divided equally between them to them and their Heirs forever

Item I give and Bequeath to the within Elizabeth Page and Sarah Cook all my Crop of Corn, wheat Tobacco &c which is to be managed by John Hill they paying him for his trouble and then equally dividing the said Crop between them for them and their Heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to William Mason a four year old Heifer to him and his Heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to Mary Baron a four year old Heifer to her and her Heirs for ever
