Item it is my Will that my Tract of Land in Ramothor County be
 sold to the highest bidder and the Money arising therefrom to be
 in the hands of my beloved wife Elizabeth Manifee for her and
 the the Family's Support

That it is my will that my beloved wife Elizabeth Manfee have and
 Enjoy all my Estate During her Natural life or Widowhood
 Then it is my Will after my wifes Decease that all my whole Estate be
 Equally Divided between all my Children then Living

That I do constitute and Appoint my Well beloved wife Elizabeth Manfee
 Executrix and my son Henry Manfee of this my last Will &
 Testament in Witness Whereof I have set my hand and put my
 seal this twenty third Day, February, in the Year of our Lord 1779.
