Last Will & Testament in manner & form as followeth
I Give & Bequeath my soul to God who gave it & my Body To be
Decently Interred at the discretion of my Executors hereinafter mentioned
I Give & Bequeath to my son in Law Richard Hackley & to his heirs
forever, one Negro man named Ralph. I also Give to Richard Hackley
all the rest of my Estate after giving each of my Children five
Shillings & paying my Debts. I appoint Richard Hackley
Sole Executor to this my Last Will & Testament. In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 19 Day of

October 1771
