and my funeral expences by my said Son James Connor who
I constitute and Appoint My whole & sole Ex^r of this my last
Will Testament revoking & Disavowing all former and other
Wills by me heretofore made: & Ratifying & Confirming this to

of May 1757

This last Will and Testament of Margreat Connor was
exhibited into Court by James Connor the Executor therein

of May 1751
his last Will and Testament of Margaret Connor Dec^d was
admitted into Court by James Connor the Executor therein
named, was proved by the Oaths of John Hackley and
Hackley Witnesses thereto, Sworn to by the said Ja^s Connor
and Certificate is granted him for obtaining a Probat thereof
in due Form he having given Security as the Law Directs
and It is Ordered that William Connor Here at Law to be
Testatrix who resides in the County of Caroline be summoned
to appear at the next Court to Contest the Validity of
said Will if he thinks fit

And at a Court held for the said County of Culpeper on
Friday the 22^d day of November 1751

The said William Connor Here at Law of the said Margaret
being duly Summoned declared he had no Objections to
make to the said Will Therefore the same is Ordered to be
