I give and Bequeath to my Grand Daughter Ann Collins one feather
Bed and furniture which she at Present lies on one Black Warming
Pan one Black cow and five Heifer my Will and Desire is that
all the Rest of my Estate Real & Personal shall be Equally Divided
Among all my Children.
I nominate and appoint James Collins and my son
Wm. Hutley Executors of this Will hereby Revoking

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And Disannulling all wills heretofore by me made Declaring this
only to be my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have here-
unto set my hand and affixed my seal this Twentieth day of
February 1777.
