until the first day of October One thousand
Hundred & fifty Seven, also I Give unto my Son
David Hawiter what money he owes me & the
Household Furniture & Tools which he has of me
in his Possession to him & his heirs forever he
paying his Sister Winifred M. then fifty Shillings

the first Child my said Negro Girl Cloe shall bring

Margaret his Wife one Negro Girl named Cloe & her

Delivering to my son Angus Hawiter the first Child
that the said Cloe shall bring or pay him ten pounds

two Sons Richard Vawter & Angus Vawter & my Daughter

Whole & sole Executor of my last Will & Testament in
Witness whereof I have hereunto put my hand & affixed my

hundred & fifty six
