I give and bequeath to Mary Monroe my wife Buck to her forever.

140 I then Give and bequeath to Belle Monroe my Colt slaving to her and her Heirs forever

I then Give and bequeath to Mary Clifton her choice of my Cows to her and her Heirs forever

I then Give and bequeath to William Tool and Joseph Allen all the rest of the rest of my whole estate to them to be equally divided between them and for them to pay of Frank's Share and to pay all my Just Debts and the Expence of my Burial. Lastly I constitute and appoint William Tool and Joseph Allen Executors and Executors of this my last Will and Testament thereby making all others void and of none effect my will and desire is that my Estate shall not be brought to an appraisment In Witness whereof
