also a Piece of Land in Culpeper County Virginia Wills 1749-1770
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the which shall be made to him and his heirs forever
Fourthly I give and bequeath unto my Beloved Son Thomas
of Land joining to the same for use of him and his heirs forever
also a Piece of Land in Culpeper County Virginia Wills 1749-1770
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that after the decease of my Beloved Wife I desire my
Son shall have my house and plantation where I now live
and his heirs forever
Fifthly It is my will and desire that the said Son shall have
Beloved Daughter Deborah the same for use of her and her heirs forever

This last Will and Testament of Peter Stone Dead was exhibited

and was proved by the oath of Samuel Blug Nicholas Nephew

Michael Leatheron ^{Curpeper County, Virginia Wills 1742-1770} and Ordered to be Proved
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said Executors at the same time refused to take the Oath of
the Execution thereof and on the Motion of Barbara Stone Widow
and Relict of the said deceased (Administrix) with the Will
annexed of the said Decedent's Estate was granted her sole having
taken the oath of an Administrator given Bond &c.
