I make this my last will & Testament utterly denying all other will or
wills by me made in manner and form following First I recommend my
soul to God that giveth living and surely believing that through the merits
of my Blessed Saviour Jesus Christ to receive full Remission and
forgiveness of all my sins my Body I commit to the Earth to be decently
and the Direction of my Executors hereafter named

Essex County, Virginia Wills 1749-1770

Primo I give unto my Daughter Elizabeth Christler one one hundred and thirty three acres
Land Beginning at three rods Chasing to John Weaver to hold to her heirs forever

Primo I give unto my Daughter Margaret Weaver one hundred & thirty
three acres of Land Chasing to Elizabeth Christler to hold to her heirs forever

Primo I give unto my Daughter Barbara (empower) one hundred & thirty
three acres of Land Chasing to Margaret Weaver to hold to her heirs forever

Primo I give unto my Daughter Catharina Weaver my Daughter having
now the use of Land where on I now live with that Plantation to be
lawfully divided between them to hold to them their heirs forever

Equally Divided Between them to hold to them their heirs forever
 I give unto my Daughter Margret and Catharina their and Hanah
 wearers Each of them one Cow & half one Blanket and Bedrock & fold them their heirs forever
 I give unto my Beloved wife Elisabeth never my House and Plantation
 all the remainder of my Estate whatsoever that is to say negroes Horses cattle hogs
 sheep home hold goods of all sorts that after her Decease or management if in Case she
 should marry then she is to have the 1/3 part of all my Estate but after her decease
 and then the 2/3 part is to fall Back to all my sons and Daughters
 to hold to them their heirs forever

And I will that all my personal Estate good & Chattels be Equally Divided amongst my
 Children that is to say John wearer Mathias Weaver Peter Weaver Barber
 Carpenter Elizabeth Chandler Margaret Weaver Chatham Weaver and Hannah
 Weaver whole to them their heirs for ever that is to say after my beloved wife's decease or Marrying
 Lastly I make and ordain my beloved son John wearer Mathias Weaver Elizabeth
 of this my last will and Testament Revoking all other wills by me made
 Witness that this is my last will & Testament I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 27th day of March
 1742
