Mark of County of Culpeper being sick & weak in Body but of sound mind &
memory Thanks to the Lord for the same calling to mind the uncertainty
of life do make & declare this my last Will & Testament in manner
Following I Impreses I do with all Humiliation & contrition for my
past sins & offences Recommending my Soul to the mercy of Almighty God
hoping thro: the merits of my Blefied Redeemer Jesus Christ after this
Mortal Body shall Return to the dust from whence it came that I shall

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Rise to a glorious Resurrection & enjoy everlasting Joy & Felicity. My Body
I commit to the Earth to be decently entred at the Discretion of my surviving
Friends

Item my will & desire is that my Just Debts be first paid & Discharged
Item I bind unto my loving wife all & every part & parcel of my Estate
during her Widowhood

Item my further will & desire is that if my wife Rachel shall marry
that she shall have a certain part of my Estate

Item my further will and desire is that all the remaining part of my
Estate shall be equally divided between my Children namely Mary
John Elisabeth Philomona and the Child my wife is now pregnant
With as they come to age

Item my further will and desire is that if any of my Children
shall depart this life without Heir that their part or that part
shall be Equally divided between my surviving Children and
their Heirs forever

Item I constitute and appoint my loving wife Rachel Executrix
of my Brother John Garner & my friends William Cave & John Guy
Executors of this my last will & Testament Revoking & Disannulling
all other Wills by me made

I my brother John Corner & my friends William Cave & John Gung
executors of this my last will & Testament Revoking & Disannulling
all other Drafting & Confirming this and no other to be my
Last will & Testament In Witness I have hereunto set my hand &
