make this last will and Testament in manner & form
following -

Culpeper County, Virginia Wills

1770-1783

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I Bequeath my soul to Almighty God that gave it me
And my Body to the earth to be Buried in a Christianlike
manner I lend to my well beloved wife Lucy all and every
of my Estate both Real and Personal for and during her
Natural Life and after my Dec^d to be in the manner
following; I lend to my beloved Ann Sharrman all & every
of my Estate both Real and Personal that shall be left after
the Dec^d of my wife Lucy and after my Debts are paid

For and during her natural life and after Decease I give the same unto
my Grandson Elisha Shorman Illegitimate Son of Ann Shorman
And all and every Individual of my lands or personal Estate that
shall be left of paying my Debts and after the death of my wife Lucy
and my Daughter Ann the same shall be and I give the same to my
said Grandson Elisha Shorman and his heirs forever

Here I appoint nominate and Ordain my well beloved Friend &
Son in Law Benjamin Heald to be my Executor and my well beloved
Ann Shorman to be my Co-Executor of this my last will and Testament
utterly Revoking all and every former will and Allowing this
and only this to be my last will & Testament
