manner. I send to my Loving wife two Negroes named
Harry and Pegg during her life and in case my son should
die before he comes of age or marries I send her a very valuable
Torn. during her life I give and Bequeath to my son

William Harford two Negro boys named Gabriel and Tom
 and after the Decease of my wife Harry and Pegg to him and
 the heirs of his Body lawfully Begotten forever, and for
 want of such Heirs I give to my Stephen Canone Harford
 after the Decease of my wife Harry Tom and Pegg to him and the
 heirs of his Body lawfully Begotten forever, and for want
 of such Heirs I give to my Stephen Benjamin Porter son of
 Archolus Porters Harry Tom Gabriel and Pegg to him and ^{the} heirs
 of his Body lawfully Begotten forever. I desire that my Son
 William Harford and Gabriel the Negro boy be bound at the
 Judge's pleasure to do what I have directed and Nicholas
 Porter to be whole and Sole Executors of this my Last will
 and Testament. In Witnes whereof I have set my hand
 and seal this 28. Day of March 1765.
