Life and after her decease in such manner as I shall hereafter

I Give and Bequeath to my son George Bledsoe Twenty Pounds Current Money to be raised out of my Estate after my Wife's Death to him his Heirs & Assigns forever,

I Give and Bequeath to my son Aaron Lauffer, his gotten Children, One Negroe Wench namede Jean & all her Children, Kate Lauffer, & Jack with all the Issue of the said Jean, Kate Lauffer & Jack, the said Jean, Kate & Jack now being in the Possession of my said son Aaron Bledsoe & the said Jean, Kate, Lauffer & Jack & all the Issue of the same thereby give to the Children of my said son Aaron their Heirs & Assigns forever.

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I Give and Bequeath to George Withersall & Milie Withersall One Negroe Wench namede Lucy now in the Possession of the said George Withersall with the Issue of the said Lucy to them the said George Withersall & Milie Withersall their Heirs and Assigns forever,

I Give and Bequeath to Ambrose Correll & Mary his Wife One Negroe Wench namede Esther now in the Possession of the said Ambrose Correll with the Issue of the said Esther to them the said Ambrose Correll & Mary Correll their Heirs & Assigns forever,

I Give and Bequeath to my son John Bledsoe One Negroe Wench namede Jack to him his Heirs & Assigns forever the said Jack being now in the Possession of the said John Bledsoe.

Item I Give and Bequeathe to my son John Bladsoe One Shilling
Married Jack to him in order to Assign forever the said Jack being the son
of John and now in the Possession of the said John Bladsoe

Item I Give and Bequeathe to my son William Bladsoe One Shilling Mar-
ried Rachel & her child with the further Issue of this said Rachel to him his
Heirs & Assigns forever the said Rachel & her child now being in the Possession
of the said William Bladsoe

Item I Give and Bequeathe to George & Mitterer the said one fourth part
of furniture to them their Heirs and Assigns forever such as shall belong to
the Estate at my Decese

Item I Give and Bequeathe to my son Aaron Bladsoe one former Bed &
furniture to him Culpeper County, Virginia Mills 1748-1750 that shall belong to the Estate at

my last Will & Testament.

And Lastly I do hereby revoke and Disannull all former
Wills by me made and do hereby Declare this to be my Last
Will & Testament. As Witness my hand & Seal this 27th day
of December 1769.

to the same ends & given her ~~the~~ ^{the} Security according to Law
