In the name of God Amen I William Gaines being at this time in perfect health and memory and is going into the army and can not tell whether I shall return I Deane to make this my will and

and Testament. It is my Will and Desire that my Land whereon my mother now lives containing one Hundred and fifty acres after my mothers Decease shall be sold and Equally Divided with all my sisters it is also my desire that my Horse and the money that I shall leave with Thomas Watts shall Equally Divided with all my sisters. It is also my Desire that Thomas Watts and James Dunn shall be my Executors Witness my hand and seal.
