Desire that if my Daughter Betty should Die without
Heir of her Body Lawfully Begotten for her Part to Return
to the Rest of her Brothers & Sisters

Lastly I institut and appoint my beloved Wife Mary
and Presby Thornton to be Executors of this my last Will

in the following manner
I ~~in~~ ^{primis} I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Mary
all my Estate during her Life or Widowhood and at her Decease
all my Estate to be Divided equally Among my Children,
shall here mention Betty Gorney, Richard, Mary, Temperance
but for three Children that she has now to live her Part them
and their Heirs for ever Henry, Jean, William, it is my
Desire that if my Daughter Betty should Die without
Heir of her Body Lawfully Begotten for her Part to Return
to the Rest of her Brothers & Sisters

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Lastly I instruct and appoint my beloved Wife Mary
and Presly Thornton to be Executors of this my last Will
and Testament In Witness whereof I confirm this to
be my last Will and Testament given under my Hand
and Seal this 7th Day of February Anno Domini
Seventeen Hundred & Sixty Seven
