Years my negro Slave Jack to him and the Heirs
of his Body Lawfully begotten forever,

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Grandson William
when he comes to the Age of Twenty one Years my
two negro Slaves Caesar & Hannah to him and the
Heirs of his Body Lawfully begotten &c

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Loving Son John
Henderson free Liberty to put all my Land and keep
same under his Use During the Term of his Natural

can get worth while and Divide the Money Equally
Between ~~himself~~ ^{my three grandsons} my three grandsons Joseph

Henderson, John Henderson and William Henderson
when Either comes of Age to them & their Heirs forever.

the Death of my son John Henderson then I Give & Bequeath
the same with every part & parcel thereof to be equally
