At a Court held for the County of Culpeper on Thursday
June 1760.

This last Will & Testament of William Kelly dec. was
brought to the Court by Robert Green Gent one of the Executors thereof
I was proved by the Oaths of William Lightfoot & Joseph
Norman Witnesses thereto, Ordered to be Recorded, the said
Executor at the same Time refused to take upon ^{him} the Burthen
of the Execution thereof And at a Court held for the County of
Culpeper on Thursday the 16th of October 1760. On the motion of John
Barrow one of the Executors in this Will mentioned Certificate was
granted him for obtaining a Probat thereof in due Form who
having sworn to the same & given Bond & Security according
to Law
