the Wife of John Mackdonald, one Negro Boy named Harry.

I Give and Bequeath unto Margaret Ward the Daughter of William Ward
deceased and Elizabeth his Wife, one Negro Boy named James.

I Give and Bequeath unto my Beloved Son Nathaniel the Wife of John

Item. My Will and desire is that the first Child she shall deliver to be given
unto Annah Jett after the date of these presents to John Hather the son
of Edward Walker and Mary his Wife,

Item. My Will and desire is that my household goods and moveable Effects
after my Wife's decease be sold at Publick Auction and the money Equally
Between Thomas Pinner, Annah Jett, Sarah Jane, Mildred Walter
and David Corbin Divided.

Item. My Will and desire is that my Wife Annah Jett be not molested but
keep, Possess and Enjoy my whole Estate till her Decease. Likewise I constitute
make Order my said Wife Annah Jett my only and sole executrix
of this my last Will and Testament and she hereby itthly doth allow
Revoke all and every other Testaments, Wills, Legacies, Bequests and Bequests
by me in any Ways before named, Willed and Bequeathed, Ratified and
Confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament. In

February One Thousand seven hundred and sixty three.
