Item I Give & bequeath unto Mary Putman one Shilling

Item I Give & bequeath unto Thomas Putman one Shilling

Item And furthermore I Leave all my Children to Doe for themselves at the Age of Sixteen after my Decease

Lastly I appoint my loving Wife Margaret Putman & John Fox Executors of this my last Will & Testament this 20th Day of March 1753
