County and Southern District being of perfect sense memory and
understanding but considering the certainty of Death and the
uncertainty of the Time thereof do think fit to make this my last
Will and Testament in manner and form following.

Witnessed It is my Will and Desire that all my just Debts be
paid as soon as as they conveniently can. Then signed by

County that it now lies in containing Seven hundred and thirty three
acres in Sum of Six hundred acres of land in the County of
York that I bequeath by a Will of my said Son to
him and his Heirs for ever. But if my said Son or his Heirs
or his Heirs should at any Time hereafter by the Advice of any
Lawyer or other Person go to Law with respect to the Six hundred
acres of of Land above mentioned, it is then my Will and desire
that the Seven hundred and thirty three acres that I give in
Lieu of it be sold to make good the Damages that other Persons
may sustain that is concerned in the said Six hundred acres, and
if that will not make the other whole and pay the Costs of Suit
all the part of my other Estate that I shall give my said Son
in this my Will shall go to Satisfie the same. Item I bequeath
my loving Wife Martha Bowber during her Widowhood five
Negros named Lesar, Sue, Tommy, Great Harry & Jenny but
if my said Wife should hereafter Marry again it is then my
Will & desire that the said Negros go to my Estate again & one
third part be divided to her and the other two thirds to my said Son

Third part be divided to her according as the Law directs in such
Cases. Item It is my Will & desire that the Land I lived on
in Spots County that Alexander Spence Head now lives on con-
taining Four hundred Acres be sold and the Money divided equally
among my four Sons Thomas Bomber, Achilles Bomber, Anthony
Bomber, and Wend Bomber, or the Survivors of any four Sons

Item It is my Will and desire that all the rest of my Estate Real
& Personal be equally divided between my four Sons Ralph,
Thomas, Achilles, Anthony & Wend Bomber. Item It is my Will

& desire that my Estate be kept together & nothing sold but as
my Ex^{ors} hereafter named shall think fit. Lastly I Recommend
& appoint my Loving Wife Martha Bomber & my two Sons

Ralph Bomber & Thomas Bomber to be to this my last Will &
