Buckingham County my whole Executors, and after all my Just debts
being fully satisfied And my funeral Expenses paid my desire is to
dispose of my whole estate in manner and form following. Item I give
and bequeath unto Tom, Thomas thirty acres of land to be laid
of whereon he now lives it being part of the tract of land whereon I
now live likewise I give - him two days in every week to labour
in for the maintainance of his wife and children to have and to hold
the said land during his Natural life and then to return to my
grandson Alex^r Duquid; Item I give and bequeath unto my
Grandson Alex^r Duquid the remainder part of my tract of land
and plantation whereon I now live after the decease of my daugh
ter Ann Duquid likewise five Slaves Tom, Thomas, Harrier,
little Tom, Absalom and Ann to receive them when ever he comes
to the age of twenty one years with the shop and Smiths tools
one bay horse colt one feather bed and furniture, one Copper Still
the said Alex^r Duquid wish to have and to hold to him and his

grandson Alex^r Duquid; Item I give and bequeath^{the} unto my
grandson Alex^r Duquid the remainder part of my tract of Land
and plantation whereon I now live after the decease of my daugh-
ter Ann Duquid likewise five Slaves Tom Thomas, Hanner,
little Tom, Absalom and Ann to receive them when ever he comes
to the age of twenty one years with the sheep and Smiths tools
one very horse toll one feather bed and furniture, one Copper Still
&c. and one black Walnut desk to have and to hold to him and his
heirs lawfully begotten for ever. Item I give and bequeath^{the} unto
my grandson George Duquid that part of my farms and houses
and wood land lying in Great Brittain which I am now possessed
with also fifty pounds current money of Virginia which he is to
receive when he comes to age of twenty one years and if he cannot
get a right to estate in Great Brittain he is to have an equal
part of my estate with the rest of my grandchildren excepting
Alex^r Duquid to have and to hold to him and his heirs lawfully
begotten for ever. Item I give and bequeath^{the} unto my grandson
William Duquid twenty pound current money of Virginia to
him and his heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath^{the} to my
daughter Ann Duquid my land and plantation whereon I now

his loving wife, her as above mentioned, with my slaves
and all my estate is to me in Great Britain and my
fourth house and woodland in Great Britain all my stock of
horns cattle hogs and sheep all my household goods and
kitchen furniture only to be to pay of and settle legacies above
mentioned after pay off as above the remainder to keep
during her natural life and after her decease the remaining part
of my estate to be equally divided between the rest of my grand-
children which is Elizabeth Patterson, Jean Cullen, John Duguid,
Martha Duguid, and Mary Duguid. In witness whereof
I have hereunto set out my hand and seal this tenth day
of February in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven
hundred and seventy two.
