and memory do hereby certify that I have made and confirmed this my last
Will and Testament first I give and bequeath to my Son Joseph
Maccan the following Negroes to wit Kate, Ned, Moll and her child
John. I also give him half my stock of Cattle except the work Oxen
and mares and all my working horses and Plows which shall
be in use on the Plantation at the time of my Death. Item I give
and Devise to my Grand son Daniel Mays and his heirs one of my
Lots in the Town of New Glasgow. Item I give and bequeath to
my Grand Daughter Mary Maccan some Acres of our common
land. Item I give and bequeath to my Grand Daughter Ann Maccan some
traced common land which is marked N.B. Item I give and bequeath
to my Daughter in Law Ann Harrington my Negroes Moll Phillips.
Item I give and Devise to my Grand Son William Mays Son of John
Mays and his heirs for ever the first choice of my Lots in the Town
of New Glasgow and all my Books. Item I give and bequeath to my
Grand Son John Mays and his heirs some of my Lots in New Glasgow.
Item I give Bequeath and Devise to my Son John Mays and to his heirs
for ever all my Lands in Cumberland County. I also give and
bequeath to my Son John Mays the following

for ever all my Lands in Cumberland County I also give and
bequeath to my Son John Mayo and his heirs for ever the following
Negroes to wit Robin Lucas Jacob Luce Puzen Berahime and
her Children with their Increase. I also give my Son John Mayo
and his heirs my last and best loved my Stocks of Hays Sheep and
Cattell except what I have already given to my Son Joseph Mayo in
this last will and Testament. And I also my Son John Mayo
my Household goods my Crops and all the rest of my Estate of what
kind or sort what so ever may be for and give my Son John Mayo and his
heirs for ever.

Now I give all my wearing Apparel to my grand Daughter Mary
Mayo. I also make and appoint my Son John Mayo Sole Executor
of this my last will and Testament. And I desire there may be no
Inventory or Appraisement of my Estate nor Security required of my
Executor and I do hereby utterly Revoke all wills and Testaments
made by me and I do appoint this my last will and Testament
in full and I have hereto set my Hand and Seal the Day and
Year above written.

at the time of my Death may stay and be on the Plantation
for the Use & Benefit of my Estate till the second February which
shall be after the date of my Death and if any Person shall
interrupt my Executor or any Person acting for him and not
fully comply with my desire as expressed in this my will and
Codicil then they shall claim no Benefit from my Will in
any Manner what ever But the hole shall go to my Son John
Mayo in Witness whereof I have set my hand & Seal this
2^d Day of January 1770.
