of Christ Jesus and my Body to be buried at the discretion of
My loving Wife and Sole Ex. and as to my worldly
Estate I bequeath as follows

Item I bequeath to my beloved Daughter Hannah Garbrough
the Land and Plantation whereon I now live containing or
near about Acres to her and her Heirs Lawfully begotten forever
After the Death of her Mother

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Hannah
Garbrough aforesaid all and every Part and Parcel of Personal
Estate to her after her Mothers Death

That my loving Wife being sole Ex. see this my last Will
fulfilled In Witness whereof I have hereunto set to my
hand and seal this fourth day of March 1749/50

that my loving Wife being sole &c. see they my last Will
testifies. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set to my
Hand and Seal this forth day of March 1749/50
