last will and testament, after committing my body to the earth and my
soul to God who gave it do will and dispose of my ^{worldly} estate in man-
ner and form following. Viz. Item I give and bequeath unto my son
Isaac Porter three Negroes (Viz.) Hampton, Jude & Peter to him and his
heirs forever after paying my ^{to} Daughter Mary Guernant thirty
pounds current money and I give my son Isaac the space of one
year and six months for payment. I also give and bequeath unto
my said Daughter Mary Guernant my Saddle. I also give and
bequeath unto my said son Isaac Porter one feather bed to him and
his heirs forever whom I charge with my just debts and funeral
Expenses. I also appoint my two sons John and William Porter
to be Executors of this my last will and testament. In Wit-
ness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and ^{fixed} my seal this
twenty fifth day of April in the year of our Lord one Thousand
seven hundred twenty two.

This last will and testament of Elizabeth Porter deceased was pre-
sented in court and proved by Haskins Landrum and Shadrach

made oath according to law certificate granted him for obtaining
a probat thereof in due form giving security whereupon he with
Samuel Flannoy his security entered into and acknowledged
bond with the condition according to law, and Liberty is reserved
to the other executor to join in probat.
