I give unto my son Daniel Robinson what he has already in possession also one negro boy named Abiram to him & his heirs also fifty Acres of Land

I give unto my son William Robinson what he has already in possession also one negro girl named Melley also fifty acres of Land to him and his heirs

I give unto my son Leah Robinson what he has already in possession and fifty Acres of Land also to him and heirs

I give unto my son Joseph Robinson what he has already in possession also one negro man named Simon to him and his heirs forever

I give unto my daughter Temperance Ingers what she has already in possession also one negro woman named Sarah to her and her heirs also one father to her and heirs

I give unto my Daughter Abigail Nichol what she has already

I give unto my Daughter Abigail Nichols what she has already
in possession also one negro woman named Eff and one pair of
bed and furniture one pair to her and her Heirs

I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Robinson two negro women Jane and Mary
also fifty acres of Land one bed half my pocket to her and her Heirs

Also one Oak Table one mirror I give unto my daughter Judith
Robinson what she has already in possession also one girl

I give unto my daughter Nancy what she has already in possession
also one negro Boy named Eff and half the pocket to her and her Heirs

Lastly I constitute and appoint my Executors Daniel Wm Wm

Robinson and Julia Robinson Executors to this my last Will
and Testament Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand

and seal this 17th of March 1785

A Court held for Cumberland County 20th March 1785.

 exhibited in Court by Felix Robinson junior one of the Executors therein
 named and proved by Harrison Jones and Stephen Robinson two
 of the Magistrates there and said to be genuine. And on the
 Motion of the said Executor who made Oath according to Law
 Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due
 form giving Security Whereupon he with Stephen Robinson
 and Thomas his Secured entered into bond
 according to Law; And liberty is given to the other Executors
 to sue in probat.
