Item. I bequeath to James Munter all the money that shall or may be due ^{the} at the time of my decease from all ^{or any} person whatsoever to him & his heirs

Item. I give & bequeath to my grand daughter Hannah Speers Holloway one feather bed & furniture as it is at the time of my decease to her & heirs forever and lastly I nominate & appoint James Munter to be my whole & sole executor & see this my will fulfilled.
