 God for the same calling to mind the uncertainty
 of this life and knowing that its appointed for
 me once to die, do make and ordain this my last

examined

Will and Testament. First I give and recommend my soul
to God who gave it me and my body I recommend to the
earth to be buried at the direction of my Executors, but
trusting my worldly Estate after my just debts are paid
I give and dispose of followeth.

Item I give unto my son Jonas Meader Holland the
 tract of land containing two hundred acres whereon he
 now lives, with every appurtenance thereunto belonging
 to him and his heirs forever my desire is also that
 my son Jonas Meader take the care of his mother and his
 sisters on him, my desire is also that such of my daugh-
 ters as are under age or unmarried shall when they come
 of age or marry be furnished with a featherbed and fur-
 niture and stocks equal to such of my children as are
 married to be given to them out of the profits of my es-
 tate before a division be made to them and their heirs
 forever. Item I lend unto my beloved wife Mary
 all the rest of my Estate both real and personal to

forever. Item I find unto my beloved wife
all the rest of my Estate both real and personal
during her natural life or widowhood and my desire
is that such of my children as are unmarried be kept to-
gether at the plantation whereon I now live and main-
taind out of the profits of my estate and my desire
is that after the death or marriage of my wife
that all my land except what is before given to my
son be sold to the highest bidder and the moneys
there arising be equally divided amongst my daugh-
ters or their legal heirs, that all rest of my estate
both real and personal be sold as above except what
is before given and the money there arising with
all I have a right to under the last will & Testament
of my wives father and mother do be equally divided
amongst my children or their lawfull heirs to them
forever notwithstanding, if my wife should mar-
ry, I desire she may have every thing coming by or

Taken out of the profits of my estate and my intention
is that after the death or marriage of my wife
that all my land except what is before given to my
son be sold to the highest bidder, and the money
there arising be equally divided amongst my wife
two, or their legal heirs, that all rest of my land
both real and personal be sold as above except what
is before given, and the money there arising with
all I have a right to under the last will & Testament
of my wife's father and mother not be equally divided
amongst my children or their lawful heirs to them
forever notwithstanding, if my wife should marry
again, I desire she may have every thing coming by or
brought with her into my estate by marriage during
her natural life, to be divided after her death as
above mentioned.

And my further desire is that if either of my chil-
dren should depart this life not having a law-
ful heir that their part of my estate be equally
divided amongst my surviving children, or their
legal representatives. I appoint and ordain my
son Jonas Meader Holland and my son-in-law
John Anderson the Executors of this my last Will &
Testament and do hereby revoke and make void
all other wills and do declare this to be my last
Will and Testament. In Witnesses whereof I have
set my hand and affix my seal this fifteenth day
of July one thousand seven hundred and eighty
three.
